Does Burundi have electricity?

Approximately 10% of the population has access to electricity, primarily in urban areas, while the electrical grid remains limited. Moreover, Burundi imports a small amount of electricity from the Democratic Republic of the Congo, underscoring its energy vulnerability.

How much energy does Burundi use a year?

Burundi's people also suffer from inadequate energy resources. Burundi produces 0.36 terawatt hours (TWh) of electricity annually, according to 2022 estimates--among the lowest totals in the world (particularly low taking into account the size of the country's population), and consumes 4 TWh annually (2021).

What challenges does Burundi face?
