Under the new pricing structure, the cost of electricity for residential consumers will rise to 35.36 dirams (\$0.032) per kilowatt-hour (kWh), up from the current 30.75 dirams (\$0.027).

Tajikistan's Ministry of Energy and Water Resources (MoEWR) has published a government resolution introducing new electricity tariffs that will take effect on February 1, 2026.
